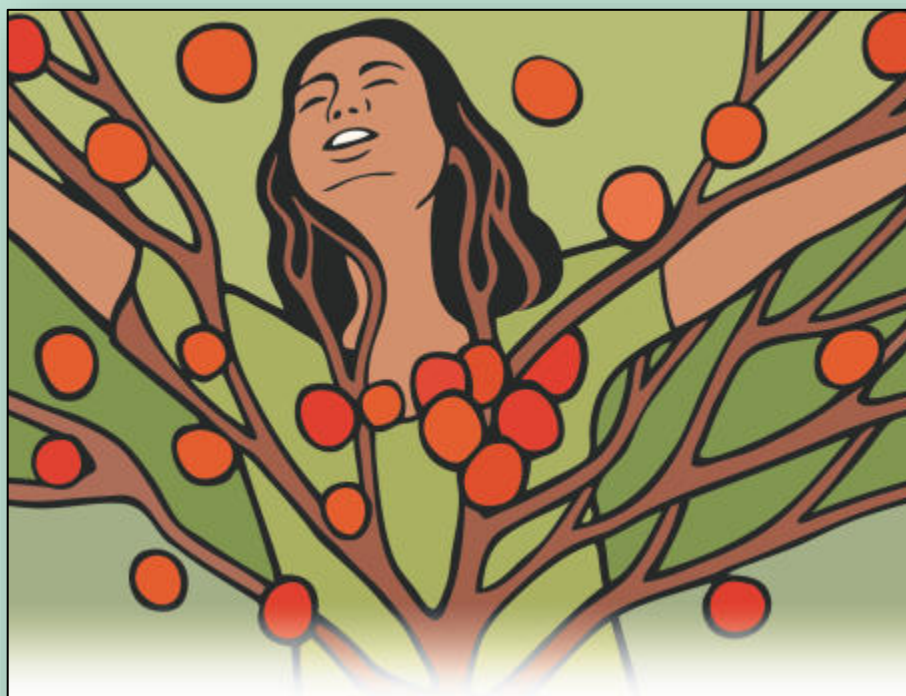

For the last two years, Holy Angels Parish has been concentrating on the Holy Spirit. We've pointed that out at our Sunday Masses and in a special way with the students and staff of Holy Angels School. Our school is very aware of the theme, "By the Spirit, We Are Called!!"

We continue that theme this Lent with a series of "Called by the Spirit" events. I call these the "CBS (Called by the Spirit) Mini-Series." Of course, our Christian Formation

Director, Hanna Bergland has already begun a successful series on Franciscan Spirituality. This Lent you are invited to an opportunity to discuss the weekend's Scripture readings. I, along with some parish staff members, will facilitate that Thursday Noon event. Also, Judge Andrew Gonring and Fr Steve Avella From Marquette University, will spend two evenings discussing how the city founders responded to the Call of the Spirit in a mini-series of how "The Founding of West Bend" and "Catholic Parishes in the Archdiocesan History: The West Bend Experience." Keep watching for other "CBS" events in the bulletin.

The highlight of Lent is of course, Sunday Mass. We will be focusing on a Lenten Homily Series entitled, "The Joy of Forgiveness." Each week develops a different insight into joy.

Lent Week 3:	The Joy of being prepared for the mission.
Lent Week 4:	The joy of experiencing Gods love in the Sacrament of Reconciliation

Easter:	The Joy of Resurrection and New Life, (Here and in the world to come.)

RICE BOWLS

Alms giving, sharing what we have with those in need, is a Lenten practice. Cardboard "RICE Bowls" from Catholic Relief Services are available in the back of church. Loose change, a tithe on one's allowance, money saved by giving up something during Lent are dropped into the bowl which may sit on the kitchen table or some other conspicuous place. They are to be brought back on Easter Sunday and their contents, large or small are divided and 75% is sent to Catholic Relief Services and 25% stays in our community. Our sacrifice then serves those in need.

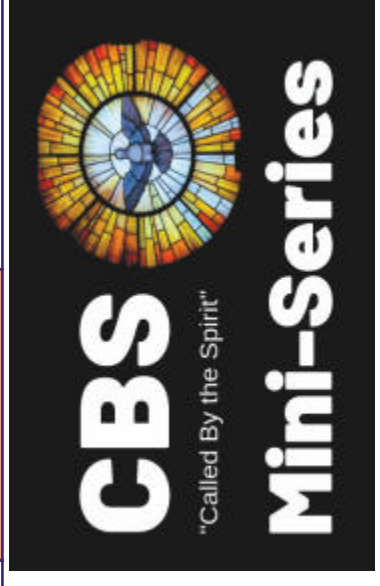
