

From the Desk of Father Jorge

The Limitless Love Of God - In the Gospel for this Sunday, Jesus is still giving the Sermon on the Mount, His first sermon. He is giving us a picture of who He is and invites us to imitate Him. What picture is this that Jesus gives us of Himself? That He is love. Nothing limits His generosity and love - nothing. If we are ungrateful to Him, He is still generous with us. If we oppose Him, disobey Him, insult Him, abandon Him - He keeps on loving us. **He simply doesn't give up on us.** The limitless love of God is what changes hearts; it's what changes the world.




In 1983, a movie came out called **"The Scarlet and the Black."** It starred Gregory Peck and Christopher Plummer. The movie is based on a true story. It told the story of Monsignor Hugh O'Flaherty, an Irish priest who was working in the Vatican when Rome was occupied by Nazi troops during World War II. This monsignor organized a secret underground network to hide and protect allied soldiers who had been shot down and Jews who were being persecuted. The drama of the story comes from the ongoing battle of wits between Monsignor O'Flaherty and the German Commander of the occupied city, Colonel Herbert Kappal. The Vatican Monsignor outsmarts the Germans long enough to save thousands of lives, but many others are lost. When the allied forces reach the outskirts of the city and the Germans are penned in, Colonel Kappal arranges a secret meeting with Monsignor O'Flaherty. He asks the Monsignor to use his underground network to take the Colonel's wife and children to safety in Switzerland. The Monsignor is flabbergasted that this unscrupulous enemy would have the gall to ask for such a favor. He chastises him for his evil ways and walks off. Only later, when the Colonel is captured and under interrogation by the allies, does he discover that the Monsignor had successfully saved his family. While the German colonel was under arrest in Rome for the remainder of the war, Monsignor O'Flaherty visited him regularly. Eventually, Colonel Kappal repented and was received into the Church. This is one example of the power of God's limitless love. He never gives up on us, because He knows that He can save us, change us, and lead us closer to Him.

Easter Candle - As we do every year, we are asking for donations for an Easter candle for each church. The Easter candles will be blessed at the Easter Vigil, Saturday, April 20th, 2018, 8:00pm. The candles are \$85 each. Thank you in advance for your generosity.

Tabernacle/Parish Renovation - As you have seen, we have placed a tabernacle in the front and center of the church in Waterloo. That's where the tabernacle should be, because Jesus is in there, really present in the consecrated hosts. The tabernacle we are currently using in Waterloo is the repository tabernacle we use during Holy Week. It's been in a closet for most of the year. If a tabernacle is going to host Jesus, the King of Kings, God, then we need a better tabernacle. We have a parish renovation fund to which some of you have been contributing to. This fund is to help us raise the necessary means to renovate both church interiors. Thank you! We are buying a refurbished tabernacle that will eventually be where the current tabernacle is. Let me know if you have any questions.
