





#### Palm Sunday/Holy Week/Easter Choirs:

A big thank you goes out to all the musicians who came forward to sing and play for Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Easter Sunday. Our church is immensely blessed to have such a large group of talented musicians to assist in mass. If you happen to see a choir member or accompanist, be sure to thank you for their gifts of time and talent!

#### What does the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM) say about the importance of singing?

Our church is blessed to be known as a "singing parish". That is to say that the congregation is great about singing the hymns and the parts of the mass. Not every church is filled with so many willing participants. But did you know that the church actually asks us to sing? According to the GIRM "39. The Christian faithful who come together as one in expectation of the Lord's coming are instructed by the Apostle Paul to sing together Psalms, hymns, and spiritual canticles (cf. Col 3:16). Singing is the sign of the heart's joy (cf. Acts 2:46). Thus St. Augustine says rightly, "Singing is for one who loves," and there is also an ancient proverb: "Whoever sings well prays twice over."

So keep up the great work! Pull out that hymnal and offer up your song as a double prayer to God!





## WHY DO WE DO THAT? - CATHOLIC LIFE EXPLAINED

### Question:

Where did the feast of Divine Mercy come from?

### Answer:

If you were born well before the year 2000, you know the feast of Divine Mercy has not always been celebrated in the Church. In the early 1900s, a young Polish nun began receiving private revelations. Jesus appeared to her during her times of prayer, speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers - the Divine Mercy Chaplet - and the request to have a feast day established to remind the Church of the mercy of God. St. Faustina died in 1938, on the cusp of war and in the midst of one of the most violent centuries in the history of the world.

Her story and her diaries began circulating in Poland and beyond. It quickly became apparent that this was a holy young woman, and the cause for her canonization opened. In the year 2000, she was canonized by the first-ever Polish pope, St. John Paul II. On her canonization day, he established the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, "a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind with experience in the years to come."

**Faith Formation****4 Things you Need to Know About Divine Mercy Sunday****1. What is Divine Mercy Sunday?**

“Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. It is based on the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, which recommended a particular devotion to the Divine Mercy.

**2. What does the Church do to encourage the celebration of devotion to the Divine Mercy on this day?**

Among other things, it offers a plenary indulgence: To ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, the Supreme Pontiff [John Paul II] himself established that this Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence, so that the faithful might receive in great abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit....

**3. What is the Divine Mercy image?**

The Divine Mercy image is a depiction of Jesus based on a vision that St. Faustina had in 1931. A basic explanation of the image is: Jesus is shown in most versions as raising his right hand in blessing, and pointing with his left hand on his chest from which flow forth two rays: one red and one white (translucent).

The depictions often contain the message ‘Jesus, I trust in You!’

The rays streaming out have symbolic meaning: red for the blood of Jesus (which is the Life of Souls), and pale for the water (which justify souls) (from Diary - 299).

**4. What is the Chaplet of Divine Mercy?**

The Chaplet of Divine Mercy is a set of prayers used as part of the Divine Mercy devotion.

They are usually said using a standard set of Rosary beads, often at 3 p.m. (the time of Jesus' death), but with a different set of prayers than those used in the Marian Rosary.”<sup>1</sup>


**Youth Ministry**




